Mayflower Walk with Godfrey Collyer (See Southampton Guide)

Friday 23rd October 2020, 11.00am to 12.30pm

In late July 1620 the ship **Mayflower** arrived in Southampton with passengers who planned to sail across the Atlantic and start new lives in the New World. Among the group were religious Separatists fleeing from persecution, while others were settlers seeking new opportunities. They were joined by the **Speedwell** with a party from Leiden, Holland and the ships spent two weeks in the port preparing for the voyage. In the 400th anniversary year of their voyage this walk will tell the story of their time in Southampton and visit some buildings and sites from that time.



The cost will be £6 per person (max no 15), open to SAS members and friends.

Meet at the Bargate, the walk lasts 90 minutes, a distance of about 700 yards with some steps into Lankester's vault, otherwise the walk is on level ground.
