


Admiral, Diplomat, Scapegoat. £8.00 plus post and packing £2.00



The story of the founder and family behind one of Victorian Britain's foremost builders, based in Southampton, but building all of the country and abroad. 159 pages, lots of illustrations.




Railway Buildings of Joseph Bull and Sons, Builders of Southampton. £4.00 plus post and packing £2.00.

A more targeted book looking at this companies influence on building the railway infrastructure across the south and south west of England. 29 pages, lots of illustrations.





A look at how Hampshire has played a key role in the development of the Telephone and associated network technology from the very early days. 14 pages



Communication often leaves no lasting imprint on the environment, however, with the growth of technology, this has changed, this is a brief introduction to the subject.





religions and types of institutions except Christian places of "worship only".


